

# What is the good news? Step 01State of Speech-Language Pathology


- Pre-professional students are frequently participating in dedicated AAC courses.

  - $2014 \rightarrow 73\%$ 0








- 81.2% of SLPs plan to participate in AAC-related continuing education and post-professional training.


**Giving and** Receiving Feedback
